

Christmas and End-of-Year functions at the Pony

We invite you to book your Christmas function or your End of Year functions at the Pony. Celebrate in a relaxed and comfortable brewery setting, enjoy your favourite beers, wines or other beverage and let the good times roll. All you have to do is enjoy yourself in the company of colleagues or family. We do the rest.

You can book a high table section or a low table section, the Beer Garden or the entire venue*

Group Booking options.

1. Groups of up to 10-15 people (small group)

You can order 'a la carte' or select items from the menu and pre-order and either pay as you go or open a tab and pay at the end of your stay.

2. Groups of 15-30 people (medium group)

To ensure that your group gets their meals at around the same time, we ask you to pre-order your meals and forward your order to us a minimum of 2 days prior to your functions. Meals can be paid individually, or you can open a tab and pay for the entire group at the end of your stay.

3. Groups of 30 people or more we have 3 options (large group)

For larger groups, we have several options available for you, from platter sharing to a sit down 3-course meal. Regardless of the choice, we have the beverage to match your food choices.

OPTION 1 - Budget menu - \$ 48 per person

Savoury shared platter for your group

- Chips, Haloumi, Popcorn Chicken, assortment of Pizzas.
- Options to add Chicken Wings is optional for an extra \$10 per head.
- Any dietary requirements must be communicated beforehand.

OPTION 2 – Christmas/End of Year function package \$65 per person

Shared savoury and Dessert platters for your group

- Chips, Haloumi, Popcorn Chicken, assortment of Pizzas.
- Chicken Wings with the option of 3 different sauces can be added for an extra \$10/head.
- Dessert platters consisting of donut balls, and fresh cut fruit platters with watermelon, cherries, grapes, stone fruits.
- Any dietary requirements must be communicated beforehand.

OPTION 3 – A 3-course meal package at \$95 per head, suitable for groups of up to 40 people.

One choice from entrée, main, dessert per person.

ENTREES:

- 1. ½ doz oysters, either Kilpatrick or natural served with shallot and red wine vinegar.
- 2. Harris smoked salmon plate, with tomato and onion salad and crackers.
- 3. Avocado cup salad (veg/vegan)

MAINS:

- 1. Slow cooked roast beef, with potatoes, salad, and red wine jus sauce.
- 2. Rolled Roast turkey stuffed with cranberry and chestnut, with potatoes, salad, and red wine jus sauce.
- 3. Vegan plant-based schnitzel, with potatoes, salad, and gravy.

DESSERTS:

- 1. Mini cheese platter with crackers.
- 2. Christmas pudding with vanilla custard.

Terms and Conditions: Group Bookings and Functions

The following terms and conditions apply to all groups and functions with 20 attendees or more.

- 1. We require a \$10 deposit per person, and all accounts must be settled in full on or before the function date. We accept payments made in Cash, Eftpos, Visa and Mastercard, or direct payment into our account (payment must be received by the function date).
- Menu: Our menu is subject to change based on seasonality and availability of produce. Please use the groups and functions menu as a guide only, demonstrating the style of food we will offer.
- 3. Public Holidays: For bookings held on public holidays, a surcharge of 25% will be added to the total bill.
- 4. Final numbers: To enable our kitchen team to prepare for your function or group booking, we ask that you provide the final number of attendees at least 7 days prior to the function.
- 5. Damage and breakages: We accept that breakages occur occasionally. However, excessive glass damages or breakages to venue items will be the responsibility of the organisers of the function/group booking, and any damage will be charged to the organisers.
- 6. Loss of goods: It is the responsibility of the organisers and guests to ensure that all items brought to the brewery are securely stored. The brewery does not accept any liability for items brought to the venue, if they are lost or damaged. This includes gifts, cameras and other personal items.
- 7. Cancellation: If a group or function booking is cancelled less than 14 days prior, the deposit is non-refundable.
- 8. Cleaning: General cleaning is included in the event cost, however if cleaning is required due to an excessive mess created during the booking/function, cleaning charges of \$50 per hour will be added. Confetti and glitter are not permitted at the venue, in either our indoor space our outdoor area.
- 9. Minors: Minors are welcome at the brewery when in the company of adults. Children must be supervised at all times, and access limits must be adhered to. Minors are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol while on the premise, and the brewery staff may request suitable proof of age to establish a person's age.
- 10. Responsible serving of alcohol: Prancing Pony Brewery serves alcohol responsibly. Alcohol will not be served to intoxicated persons, or to persons under 18 years of age.
- 11. Liability: Prancing Pony Brewery conducts functions and group bookings in compliance with the Liquor Licensing Act, and we reserve the right to exclude or remove any person from the brewery that does not comply with these laws, without liability to the attendees or organiser.
- 12. For bookings of the entire venue a venue charge applies. Venue charges for bookings between Monday to Thursday will be charged differently to venue charges for bookings between Friday and Sunday. Please discuss your requirements with management.
- 13. A minimum spend is required for full Venue bookings.
